

## **Section Two**

### **VITAL AND HEALTH STATISTICS**

This section presents data on births, deaths, life expectancy, marriages, diseases, and patient visits and hospital discharges.

Mid-year population estimates between 1991 and 1999 were adjusted due to the low count from the 2000 census. Consequently, rates and ratios have also been adjusted because of the abovementioned reason.

The American Samoa Crude Birth Rate has dropped from 30 per 1,000 persons in 2000, to about 26 in 2005. Females under 20 years old accounted for about 5.9 percent of mothers who gave birth. Mothers aged 20 to 29 accounted for another 54 percent of total live births. The American Samoa Crude Death Rate remained at 4 per 1,000 persons throughout the years. Infant mortality rate (death under one year of age) dropped to 7 per 1,000 live births compared to 15.2 per 1,000 live births in 2004. Population natural growth is defined as total births minus deaths. Assuming both vital registration systems are complete, the natural growth of the resident population in 2005 is at 1,440. In the past five years, a 1,400 people is added to the resident population every year because of natural growth.

Heart disease remained the leading cause of death in the territory followed by Malignant Neoplasm. Outpatient visit by clinic have dropped from about 180,000 visits in 2001 to 140,000 in 2004, and then went up again to 160,000 in 2005. Hospital discharge data and Notifiable Diseases were not available for current years.

Marriages recorded an all time low of only 202 in 2005 compared to an average of about 290 in the past three years. Life expectancy at birth for males is at 68.5 years versus 76.2 years for females.

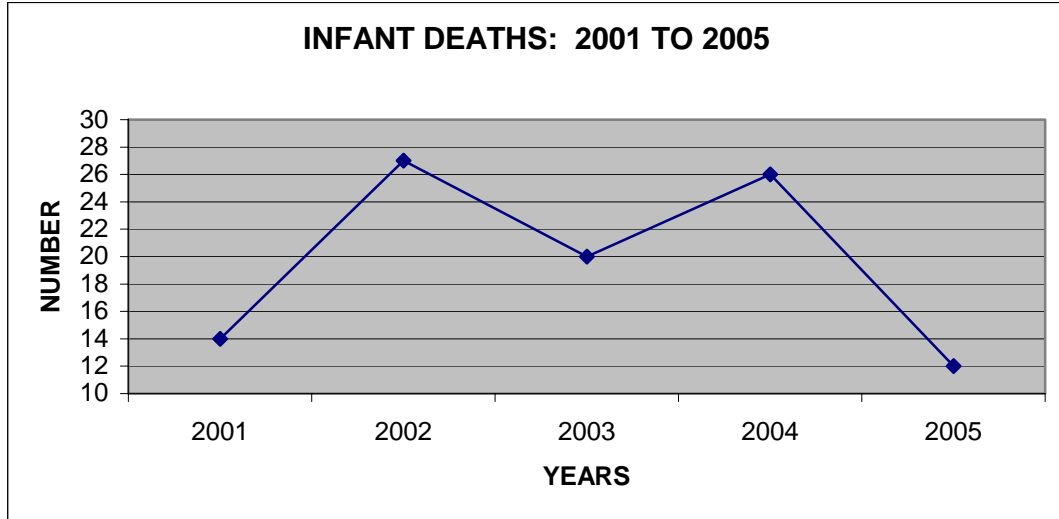

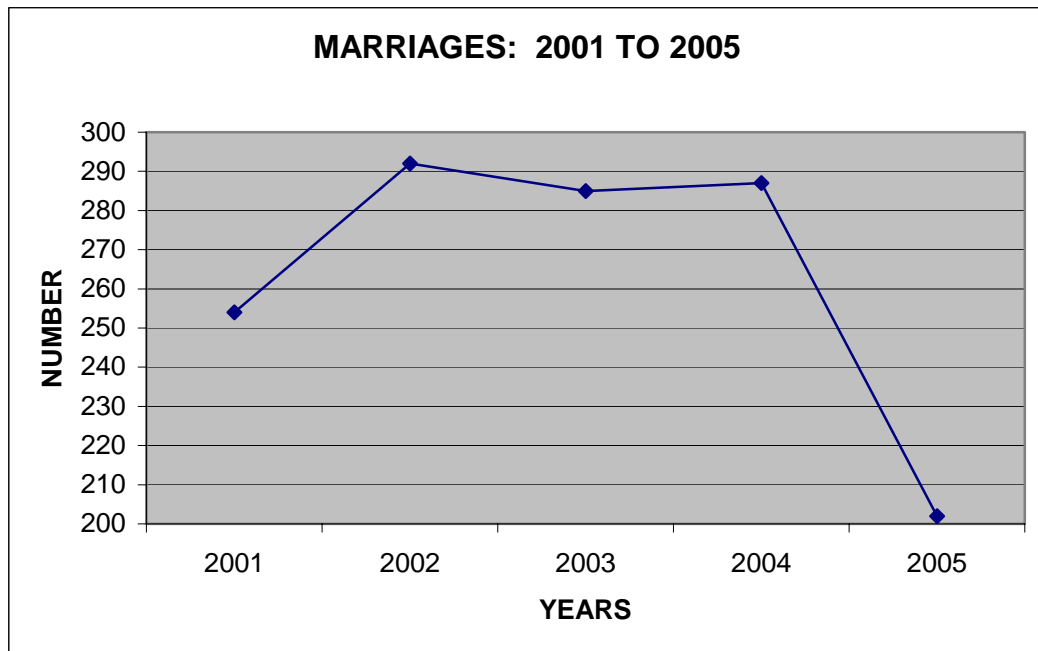
